For anyone unfamiliar with the Footscray Cycling Club, it is one of the oldest and most respected clubs in Victoria. We have between 100-200 members and provide for racing all year round. We are affiliated with AusCycling and are regularly represented in Open races (conducted by AusCycling).

During the Road Season (April-October), we conduct racing over a number of different circuits ranging in distance from 75 KM to 125 KM. On any given Saturday or Sunday, there'll usually be 50-80 riders, so everyone is assured of good racing. Little River races start from the clubrooms at the Little River Cricket Ground. Maude/Meredith races start from the Maude Tennis Courts. Balliang races start from Balliang Hall. Lethbridge races start from Lethbridge Hall.

Some races are restricted to Club members. Refer to our fixtures for more details.

During the Criterium season (October-March), we have races on Thursday evenings (VU circuit in Hoppers Crossing) and weekend mornings Saturdays at the VU circuit in Hoppers Crossing or Sundays at Drake Blvd in Altona.


Our daily existence is powered by dedicated volunteers and built on a foundation of fun and inclusion.


