General Notice:

All teams and athletes are being issued noticed that it is expected that all athletes participate at the fullest of their ability and respect the privilege of racing in a National Championships and also to respect the competition and your fellow competitors. These Championships are not the forum to utilise the resources for other purposes other than to compete for National Titles.

All athletes are reminded of the following UCI regulations:

1.2.080: All license holders shall, in whatever capacity, participate in cycling races in a sporting and fair manner. They shall look to contributing fairly to the sporting success of the race.

1.2.081 Riders shall sportingly defend their own chances. They shall always act in their own sporting interest in the event and the sporting interest of their team. Any collusion or behavior likely to falsify or go against the interests of the competition shall be forbidden.

In the opinion of the Commissaire Panel, any athlete breaching these regulations, may be penalised by means of disqualification from the competition.

General Notice

1. Reference UCI Article 1.3.033: Socks and overshoes used in competition may not rise above the height defined by half the distance between the middle of the lateral malleolus and the middle of the fibula head.

Athletes and managers may be penalised under the AusCycling Technical Regulations for breaches of this requirement. The penalty is a fine for both the athlete and the team manager of \$50 per occurrence. Please ensure all athletes comply with this regulation.



2. All teams are asked to remind their athletes that they are to exit the track from the back straight and the maximum warm down after their event is 2 ½ laps. Failure to comply with this request may result in the following penalty in accordance with the AusCycling Regulations: 1st offence \$100 fine, 2nd offence, \$100 fine and disqualification.
